



# DURHAM COLLEGE: YOUR IMPACT IN 2019

CONTRIBUTIONS TO FACE-OFF AGAINST HOMELESSNESS: \$15,000

Durham Outlook for the Needy is a non-profit organization established in 1990 by local residents. Durham Outlook's core program is St. Vincent Pallotti's Kitchen - Durham Region's only seven-day-a-week, 365-day-a-year soup kitchen. With the leadership of more than 1,200 volunteers per month, St. Vincent Pallotti's Kitchen serves an average of 150-200 people per day who are experiencing poverty and food insecurity. Annually, it serves an average of 50,000 meals per year. Since 1990, it has served 1.3 million meals.



## DURHAM OUTLOOK: AN ACCESSIBLE FACILITY

Net proceeds from the 2019 HHTH Durham College Tournament have gone directly towards helping Durham Outlook serve meals 365-days-a-year, and also get closer to the fundraising goal of \$1.5 million to provide a fully accessible facility to their growing number of patrons.

**49% of the GTA's food bank users have a physical disability that Durham Outlook cannot currently accommodate, which is why it is so important to expand and have a fully accessible facility.**

Durham Outlook hopes to continue to serve the needs of the community by continuing to offer the low cost, nutritious meal, but also plan on using the funds to support the construction of a new, 100% accessible facility to serve meals in and store food. They anticipate a 30% increase in patronage at the new location and know that they will be able serve a wider community once they have an accessible facility.
